




# Gin Menu



## Gordons 37.5% - £3.80

The worlds best selling gin, with a secret recipe known only by 12 people in the world.  
Best served with a lemon wedge.

## Beefeater 40% - £3.80

A classic London dry gin with a strong juniper kick, enhanced by citrus fruits.  
Best served with a lime wedge

## 1606 43% - £4.00

Local to Tunbridge Wells, 1606 is named after the year the spring was discovered. This small batch gin is made using Tunbridge Wells spring water & Seville orange & limes.  
Best served with lemon, lime & orange wedge

## Hendricks 41.4% - £4.20

Best know as being served with cucumber to compliment its fresh taste and subtle juniper notes.  
Best served with a slices of cucumber

## Boodles 40% - £4.00

Infused with nutmeg, rosemary & sage Boodles use no citrus botanicals in distilling of their gin, they believe the citrus should be added to the glass not the gin. Boodles gin was reportedly a favourite of Churchill, who are we to disagree?

Best served with a lime wedge & juniper berries

## Sipsmiths 41.6% - £4.20

A particularly dry gin with a zesty, citrus finish. The quintessential expression of a classic, traditional London dry gin. Bold, complex and aromatic – smooth enough for a Martini, but rich and balanced, perfect for a G&T.  
Best served with red chilli, lime wedge & coriander

## Whitley Neal 42% - £4.20

Standard botanicals of juniper, coriander, orange peel, lemon peel, angelica, cassia, orris. Whitley Neill adds in the African botanicals that are the cape gooseberry and the baobab fruit.

Best served with rosemary, lemon & black pepper

## Tanqueray 37.5% - £4.50

Very fresh and smooth on the nose with slight hints of juniper and citrus coming through. A good hit of liquorice is present on the palate, with a slight spice that creates a long tingle.

Best served with grapefruit & juniper berries

## Bulldog 37.5% - £4.10

Bulldog is made from Norfolk wheat from the fertile East Anglia region of England, Britain's purest fresh water from Wales and a distinctive blend of 12 botanicals from 8 countries around the world.

Best served with lemon wedge, fresh basil & juniper



## Bombay Sapphire 40% - £3.80

A firm favourite. Bombay Sapphire has a ripe citrus aroma with spice and a touch of juniper.  
Best served with a lemon peel & coriander seeds

## Greensand Ridge 40% - £3.80

A classic London Dry Gin with 8 local botanicals that grow in the woods beneath the Greensand Ridge. Bottle distilled in Shipbourne, Kent  
Best served with bay leaves

## Bloom 40% - £4.50

A light, delicate and oral gin with a totally unique slightly sweet taste created by a bespoke blend of 3 botanicals: honeysuckle, chamomile and pomelo.  
Best served with strawberries

## Plymouth 41.2% - £4.20

Crafted in Englands oldest distillery and distilled with soft dartmoor botanicals. Plymouth was the first gin to be used in a martini.  
Best served with lemon zest & cracked black pepper
