Gordons London Dry - 37.5%

£3.50

The world's best-selling gin, with a secret recipe known only by 12 people in the world

Served with a lemon wedge

Beefeater London Dry - 40%

£3.50

A classic London dry gin with a strong juniper kick enhanced by citrus fruits.

Served with a lime wedge

1606 Tunbridge Wells - 43%

£4.00

Local to Tunbridge Wells, 1606 is named after the year the spring was discovered. This small batch gin is made using Tunbridge Wells spring water & Seville oranges & limes

Served with lemon, lime & dried orange peel

Hendricks - 41.4%

£4.20

Best known served with cucumber to compliment its fresh taste and subtle juniper notes.

Served with sliced cucumber

Boodles - 40%

£3.50

Infused with nutmeg, rosemary & sage, Boodles use no citrus botanicals in the distilling of their gin. They believe the citrus should be added to the glass not the gin. Boodles gin was reportedly a favourite of Winston Churchill, who are we to disagree?

Served with a lime wedge & juniper berries

Sipsmiths 41.6%

£4.20

A particularly dry gin with a zesty, citrus finish. The quintessential expression of a classic, traditional London dry gin. Bold, complex and aromatic – smooth enough for a Martini but rich and balanced for a G&T.

Served with red chilli, lime wedge & coriander

Bombay Sapphire - 40%

£3.80

A firm favourite. Bombay Sapphire has a ripe citrus aroma with spice and a touch of juniper.

Served with lemon peel

Whitley Neal - 42%

£4.20

Standard botanicals of juniper, coriander, orange peel, lemon peel, angelica, cassia & orris. Whitley Neal adds the African botanicals that are the cape gooseberry and the baobab fruit.

Served with rosemary, lemon & black pepper

Tanqueray - 37.5%

£4.50

Very fresh & smooth on the nose with slight hints of juniper and citrus coming through. A good hit of liquorice is present on the palate, with a slight spice that creates a long tingle.

Served with grapefruit & juniper berries

Bulldog - 37.5%

£4.10

Bulldog is made from Norfolk wheat from the fertile East Anglia region of England, Britain's purest fresh water from Wales and a distinctive blend of 12 botanicals from 8 countries around the world.

Served with lemon, fresh basil & juniper berries

Monkey 47 - 47%

£4.80

Monkey 47 is a Dry Gin that is made from local spring water in the German Black Forest and aged in stoneware barrels. The number 47 refers to the total sum of 47 botanicals used for this gin - among them are local specialties as well as exotic herbs. As a result, Monkey 47 Gin boasts a distinct and pure aroma of juniper accentuated by a crisp citrus note, sweet floral aroma, a hint of peppery spices and subtle bitter fruit.

Served with fresh lavender

Bloom - 40%

A light, delicate and floral gin with a totally unique slightly sweet taste created by a bespoke blend of 3 botanicals; honeysuckle, chamomile and pomelo.

Served with strawberries

Greensand Ridge - 40%

£3.80

A classic London dry with 8 local botanicals that grow in the woods beneath the Greensand Ridge. Bottle distilled in Shipbourne, Kent.

Served with bay leaves

Tanqueray No. TEN - 47.3%

Inspired by Charles Tanqueray's pursuit of perfection, Tanqueray No. Ten is distilled in small batches with fresh whole citrus fruits and the finest hand-selected botanicals. This is the ultimate gin!

A progressive exploration of the heritage of the Isle of Islay. Nine classic gin botanicals are augmented by 22 local herbs and flowers, foraged by hand.

Served with dried orange peel

Caorunn - 41.8%

£4.25

Carefully handcrafted in the Scottish Highlands, Caorunn expertly infuses five locally foraged gin botanicals. Artisanal and small batch, beautifully mixing the rugged charm of Speyside with the urban sophistication of modern Scotland.

Served with sliced apple

Anno - 43%

£4.00

Multi-award winning gin incorporating Kentish botanicals such as hops, samphire and local florals to create an outstanding gin with the unique flavour of Kent.

Served with dried orange peel and juniper berries

Star of Bombay - 47.5%

A bolder expression of Bombay Sapphire's signature style. With two additional botanicals, carefully selected then slowly distilled for a more intense flavour.

Saffron Gin - 40%

£3.80

Saffron Gin is the result of an alliance between Great Britain for its London Dry Gin, India for its spice used extensively in cooking and in religious ceremonies, and French know-how developed by Gabriel Boudier. This original product with exotic notes is manufactured entirely in Dijon and is used in numerous cocktails, the most famous being Saffron gin and tonic.

No.3 London Dry - 46%

No.3 is the London Dry Gin distilled to a proprietary recipe of Berry Bros. & Rudd, London's oldest wine and spirit merchant. The name No.3 refers to the address in St James's Street, London, their home since 1698. No.3 was created to be the last word in gin for a Dry Martini. With juniper at its heart, it unashamedly celebrates the integrity and character of a classic London Dry Gin: six perfectly balanced botanicals distilled in traditional copper pot stills.

Served with pink grapefruit

Martin Miller's - 40%

Martin Miller's Original Gin, is pot distilled using two separate distillations. This imparts a unique balance of citrus and juniper. Blended to a bottling strength of 40% ABV using Icelandic Spring Water.

Served with rosemary, lemon & cracked black pepper

Opihr - 40%

£3.80

Opihr Oriental Spiced Gin has bursts of Citrus balanced with the rich, earthy aromas and a soft spice. Opihr epitomises the exotic intensity of the Orient, awakening the senses to a new style of gin.

Served with sliced ginger

Plymouth - 40%

A rich fresh aroma of juniper followed by notes of coriander and cardamom. Extremely smooth and creamy on the palate with a slight sweetness.
